Program Information

Coast Hotels & Resorts Athlete Assistance Program (CAAP) has been developed to support the dreams of athletes who represent Canada on the world stage. Specifically, Coast Hotels & Resorts wants to support those athletes that are currently training with one of Canada's National teams but do not currently receive Sport Canada funding (AAP carding).

Coast Hotels & Resorts will pay the approved training costs of selected athletes, up to a maximum of \$10,000 on an annual basis, including such eligible items as:

- National Team training and coaching fees
- Competition expenses (travel and fees)
- Sport Medicine and Science expenses
- Uniforms and Sport apparel expenses for training and competition

Athlete Commitment

- The athlete will maintain a position of good standing with his/her National Sport Organization;
- The athlete will maintain a sport performance diary of key achievements in training and competition and be prepared to communicate with the Hotel property on a periodic basis of his/her training and competition journey;
- The athlete will meet with the Hotel staff at least two times per year to speak of his/her sport training, competitions and the path taken to achieve their dreams;
- The athlete will be an active contributor within their community.

The award will be for one year, renewable annually for a three-year period, based on maintenance of eligibility.

Athletes chosen to participate in this program must reflect the values and operating principles of Coast Hotels & Resorts.

Preference will be given to athletes currently training with Canadian National teams who do not receive Sport Canada funding (AAP carding) and are in good standing with their National Sport Organization (NSO) and Provincial Sport Organization (PSO)

Athletes must be registered with PacificSport in British Columbia or with the Canadian Sport Centre Calgary (CSCC) in Alberta.

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee from each Coast Hotel property. The selection criteria may vary slightly from one property to another.
